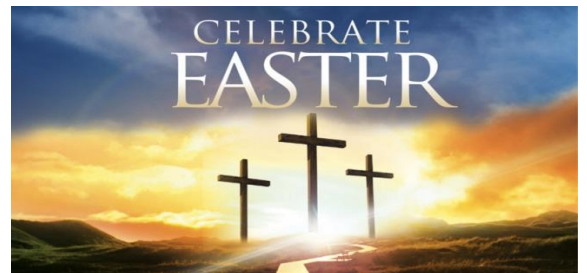
Years 3 and 4 Half Term Workshops
