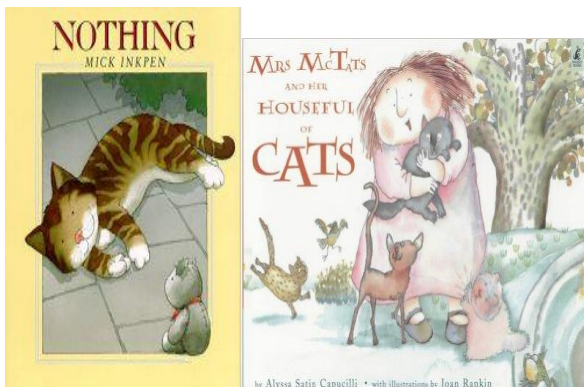

Just a reminder that our termly parent/teacher consultations take place next week on the 14th and 15th March.



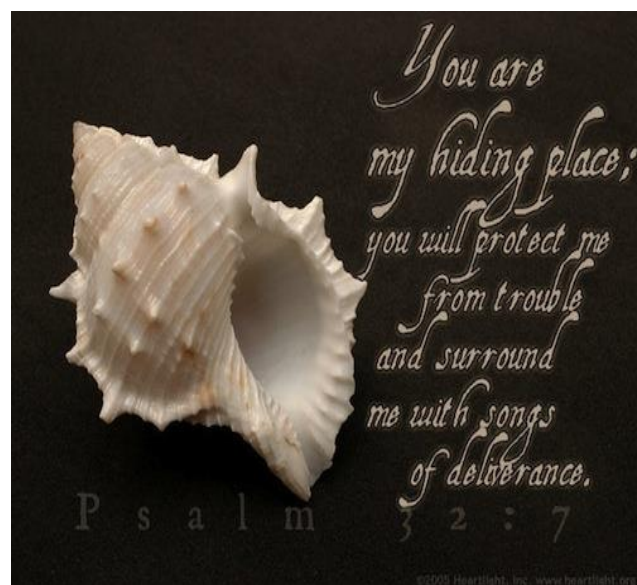
Easter Service
