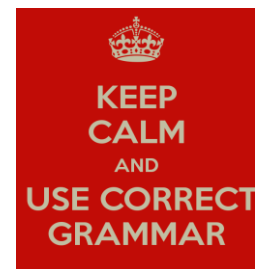
Christmas Fete
