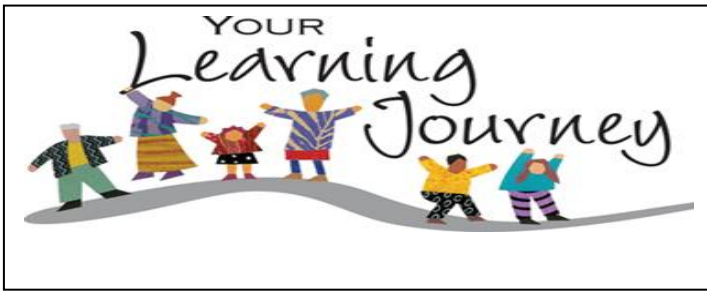

Summer has arrived.....

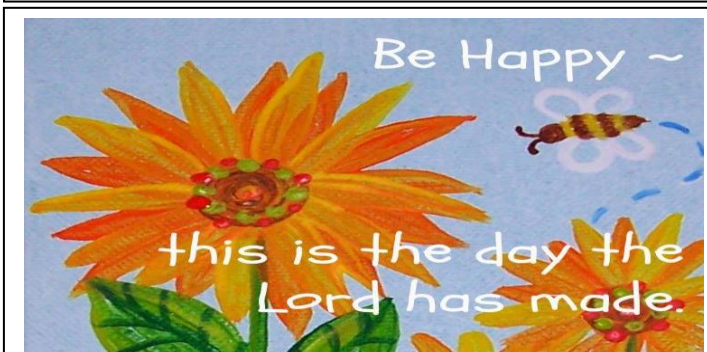
