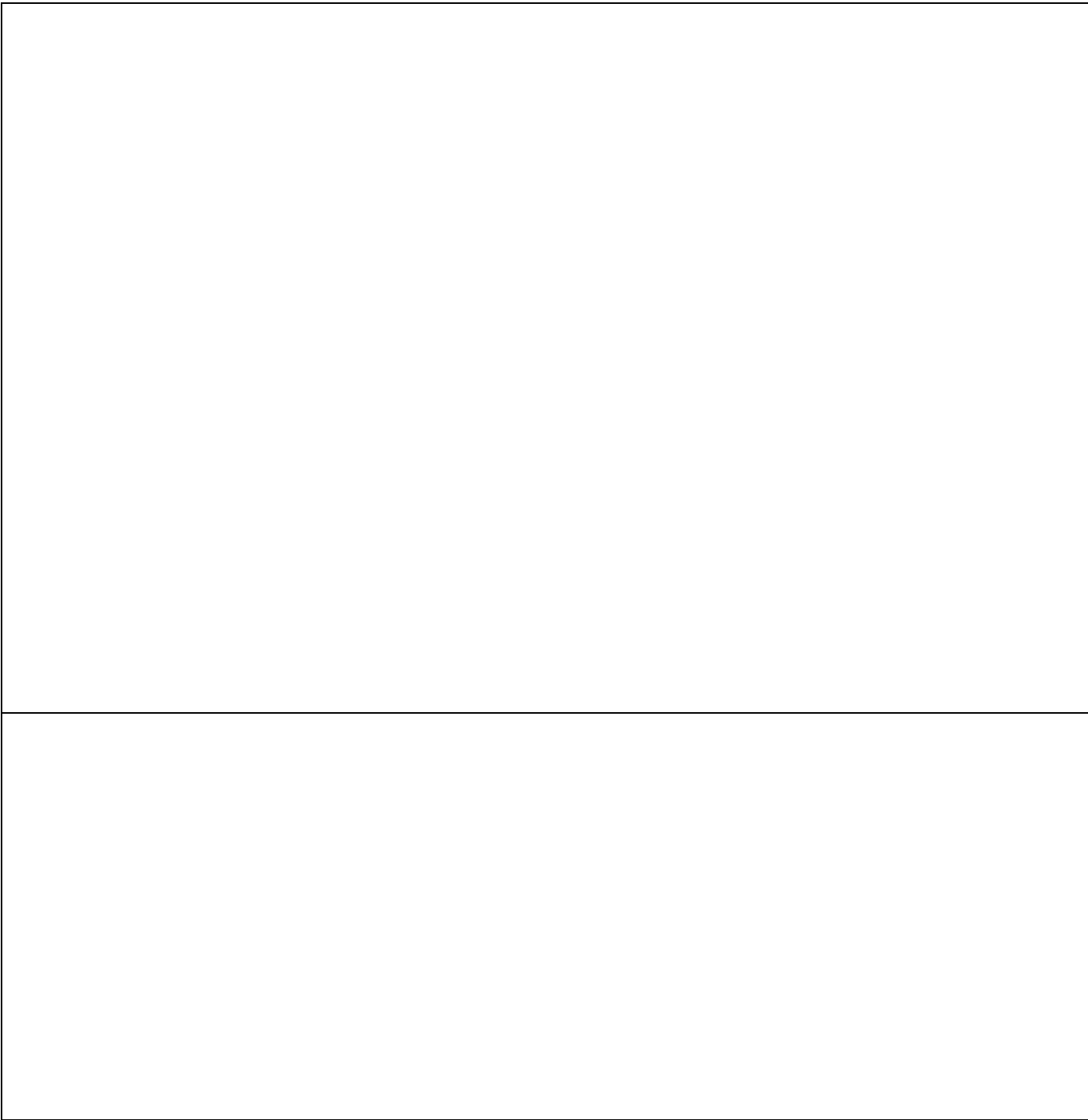


Meet the Head Teacher...
