The team's win will be officially unveiled on the 'Apps for Good Awards' page of the 'Apps for Good' website next week.

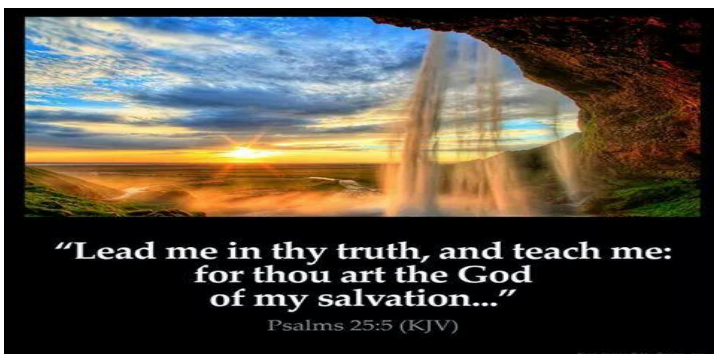
The children will also be attending a very prestigious event on the 20<sup>th</sup> June at the Barbican where they will be officially presented with their prize.
