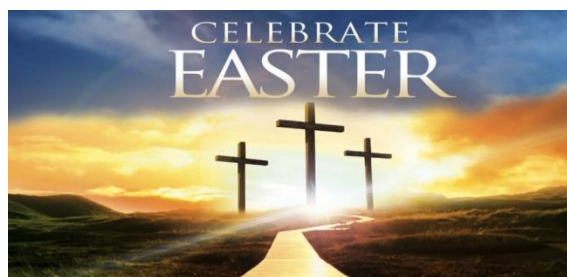
Parents' Evening
