2016/2017 SPORT PREMIUM SPENDING PLAN

Our School

In 2016/2017 Holy Trinity Primary School has so far received **£5125 + an additional £3000** in Sports Premium funding for our children.

We use the money in the following ways:

- PE provision from an outside agency-Fit for Sport and a Qualified Sports Coach who makes a valuable contribution to improving the quality and range of school sport offered in our school.
- Purchase of a range of equipment to enhance PE sessions and playtimes, to introduce different sports to children and allow them to explore new challenges.
- Paying for Swimming Lessons with qualified coaches at the local swimming pool-this applies for Years 3-5.
- Membership in the Lewisham Primary School Sports Association, which enables us to access a range of local sports tournaments and festivals and be involved in inter-school sports.

How do we know it is making a difference?

- Children enjoy a range of sports during their PE lessons.
- Regular monitoring of pupil participation in sporting activities and after school clubs
- Playground activities have helped to improve behaviour at playtime which aids concentration and learning in the classroom.
- All Key Stage 2 children are given an opportunity to learn to swim-a valuable life skill.
- Children are regular ambassadors for the school in a range of different sporting activities.
- Promotion of a healthier lifestyle in all our children across the school who benefit from weekly PE lessons.
